Principles Regulating the Coordination Procedure

If, during the programme for scheduling the infrastructure capacity applications, CFR has to deal with competing applications, the procedure shall be as follows:

- CFR shall ensure the best correlation of these applications
- If a coordination is necessary, CFR shall propose to the applicants infrastructure capacities that are different from the allocated capacities
- If possible, CFR shall propose deviating routes or shall propose the delaying of the requested paths
- The possible conflicts shall be settled by consultation between CFR and the relevant applicants
- The preparation of the paths for the international trains shall have priority

The coordination principles shall apply to all the applications when an application for infrastructure capacity cannot be satisfied within the scheduling process and it requires coordination.

The applicant may submit to CFR a contestation regarding the infrastructure capacity allocation, in accordance with the provisions of Art. 30 of the GD no. 89/2003. CFR shall communicate the settlement modality of the contestation within 10 working days.
