EUROPEAN COMMISSION TAIEX¹-REGIO PEER-2-PEER²: EXPERTS MISSION on railway infrastructure projects under ESI Funds

In the period 03-05 of October 2017, in Bucharest, Romania an event organised and financed by the *European Commission Directorate General REGIO and NEAR TAIEX Peer-2-Peer Unit* took place with the collaboration of *CNCF CFR-SA (Romania)* and *PKP PLK-SA (Poland)*.

The aim of event was to increase the inter-institutional capacity of the railway infrastructure manager from *Romania - CNCF CFR-SA* by organizing an expert's mission at its headquarters in Bucharest.

Two PKP PLK-SA experts selected by the European Commission provided guidance on the monitoring of projects financed through the ESI programs for the transport sector. They presented the successfully implemented railway projects within the trans-European transport network TEN-T program completed or under-execution funded by national or EU grants/ subsidies and the successfully implemented project management system at PKP PLK-SA.
